



## BUCKS COUNTY BROWNSTONE

### *GUILLOTINE CUT STONE*

*The traditional, early American appearance of Bucks County Brownstone often makes it the obvious choice.*

### BUCKS COUNTY BROWNSTONE

Type: Sandstone.

Color: Shades of reddish-brown, varying from pink-grey thru medium red to deep red.

Shape: Ashlar and rubble.

Size: Faces from ½ sq. ft. to 1½ sq. ft.

Coverage: 4" veneer—35-40 sq. ft. per ton.

6" veneer—30-35 sq. ft. per ton.

8" veneer—25-30 sq. ft. per ton.

☐ Larger facings may be available, depending on the run of material.

☐ Exact coverage depends on building design and masonry techniques.

☐ Colors can be custom-blended to meet individual requirements, for example, to match existing stonework. However, as a naturally occurring property of the stone, color will vary.
